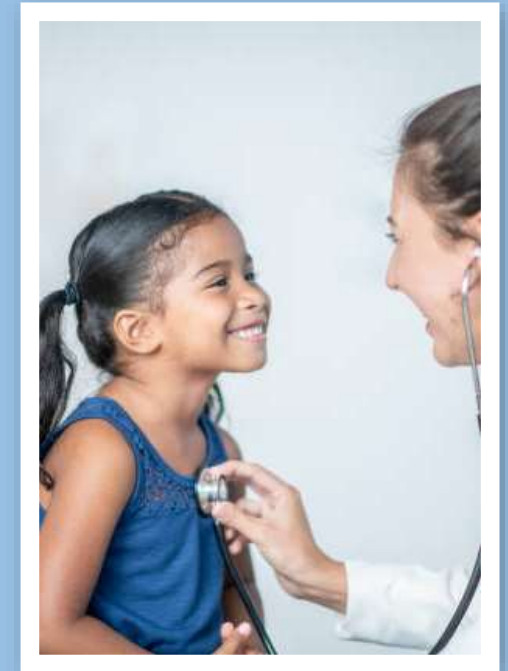

6 month - 2-year-olds (6 months through 2nd birthday)

General and Immunization:

1. Is the patient up to date on Well child? Y/N
 - The patient must be up to date on Well child visits (on pace to complete 6 visits by 15 months plus 2 more visits by 24 months).

2. Is the patient up to date on immunizations? Y/N
 - On pace to finish COMBO 10 i.e four diphtheria, tetanus and acellular pertussis (DTaP); three polio (IPV); one measles, mumps and rubella (MMR); three haemophilus influenza type B (HiB); three hepatitis B (HepB), one chicken pox (VZV); four pneumococcal conjugate (PCV); one hepatitis A (HepA); two or three rotavirus (RV); and two influenza (flu) vaccines by their second birthday).

If NO

2a. Vaccine refusal? Y/N

Any documentation in the chart that the patient did not receive immunizations due to “Vaccine Refusal”.

2b. Is there a catch-up schedule being implemented? Y/N

Not on pace to get COMBO 10 by age 2 but documentation that a “catch up” schedule is being implemented.

General and Immunization:

3. Was a Reach Out and Read book given? Y/N
- ❑ Any documentation in their chart that their family read stories, sing songs, or were given a reach out and read book at the last well child visit.



6 month - 2-year-olds (6 months through 2nd birthday)

Screenings:

4. Is there a screen for postpartum depression in the chart? Y/N
 - Any documentation in the chart that the mother has been screened for depression in the first 3 months of the child's life.

5. Is there a screen for development in the chart? Y/N
 - Any documentation in the medical records that a standardized developmental screening has been performed.

6. Is there a screen for Autism in the chart? Y/N or not appropriate
 - Any documentation in the records that a standardized autism screening has been completed.

6 month - 2-year-olds (6 months through 2nd birthday)

Screenings:

7. Is there a screening for SDOH in the chart? Y/N

- Any documentation in the chart that the family has been asked questions about social determinants of health at a health supervision visit in the past 12 months.

If YES

7a. Was the screening positive? Y/N

- Any documentation in the chart that the family has been asked questions about social determinates of health at a health supervision visit in the past 12 months and the screen is positive.

6 month - 2-year-olds (6 months through 2nd birthday)

Preventative Oral Health:

8. Was an oral exam done? Y/N

- Any documentation in the records that an oral exam was done at least once in the last 12 months.

9. Was an oral health risk factors assessment done? Y/N

- Any documentation in the records that an oral health risk assessment (risk factors for caries- per AAP Oral risk assessment tool) was done at least once in the last 12 months.

10. Was a fluoride varnish applied? Y/N or not appropriate

- Any documentation in the records that a fluoride varnish has been provided at least once in the last 12 months.

11. Was an anticipatory guidance on oral health given? Y/N

- Any documentation in the record that anticipatory guidance on oral health (as per bright futures) was given at the last well child visit.

12. Was the patient referred to a dental home? Y/N/already established/or not appropriate

- Any documentation in the record that the patient has a dental home or has been referred to a dental home.

General and Immunization:

1. Is the patient up to date on Well child visits? Y/N
 - Any documentation that the patient is up to date on Well child visits (had at least 1 well child visit in the past 12 months)?

2. Has the patient completed the COMBO 10 immunization? Y/N
 - Any documentation in the chart that the patient is up to date on immunizations (has completed the COMBO 10 - four diphtheria, tetanus and acellular pertussis (DTaP); three polio (IPV); one measles, mumps and rubella (MMR); three haemophilus influenza type B (HiB); three hepatitis B (HepB), one chicken pox (VZV); four pneumococcal conjugate (PCV); one hepatitis A (HepA); two or three rotavirus (RV); and two influenza (flu) vaccines by their second birthday).

2 year - 5-year-olds (25 months - 60 months or 2 years through 5th birthday)

General and Immunization:

2a. Vaccine refusal? Y/N

Any documentation in the chart that the patient did not receive immunizations due to “Vaccine Refusal”.

2b. Is there a catch-up schedule being implemented? Y/N

Patient did not receive all the vaccines recommended but there is documentation that a “catch up” schedule is being implemented.

2 year - 5-year-olds (25 months - 60 months or 2 years through 5th birthday)

General and Immunization:

3. Was a Reach Out and Read book given? Y/N
 - Any documentation in the chart that the family read stories, sing songs, or were given a reach out and read book at the last well child visit.

4. Was a photometric vision screening done? Y/N
 - Any documentation in the chart that a photometric vision screen was done in the last 12 months.

2 year - 5-year-olds (25 months - 60 months or 2 years through 5th birthday)

Screenings:

5. Is there a screen for Autism in the chart? Y/N
 - Any documentation in the chart that a standardized autism screening has been completed.

6. Is there a screen for development in the chart? Y/N
 - Any documentation in the medical records that at least 2 development screenings have been performed.

Screenings:

7. Is there a screening for SDOH in the chart? Y/N

- Any documentation that the family has been asked questions about social determinants of health at a health supervision visit in the past 12 months.

If YES

7a. Was the screening positive? Y/N

- Any documentation that the family has been asked questions about social determinants of health at a health supervision visit in the past 12 months and the screen is positive.

2 year - 5-year-olds (25 months - 60 months or 2 years through 5th birthday)

Preventative Oral Health:

8. Was an oral exam done? Y/N

Any documentation in the records that an oral exam was done at least once in the last 12 months.

9. Was an oral health risk factors assessment done? Y/N

Any documentation in the records that an oral health risk assessment (as per the AAP Oral risk assessment tool) was done at least once in the last 12 months.

2 year - 5-year-olds (25 months - 60 months or 2 years through 5th birthday) Preventative Oral Health:

10. Was a fluoride varnish applied? Y/N

- Any documentation in the records that a fluoride varnish has been provided at least once in the last 12 months.

11. Was an anticipatory guidance on oral health given? Y/N

- Any documentation in the record that anticipatory guidance on oral health(per bright futures) was given at the last well child visit.

2 year - 5-year-olds (25 months - 60 months or 2 years through 5th birthday) Preventative Oral Health:

12. Was the patient referred to a dental home? Y/N/already established

Any documentation in the record that the patient has a dental home or has been referred to a dental home.

13. Did the patient have any restorative dental procedures? Y/N

Any documentation in the record that restorative dental procedures were done if needed.

General and Immunization:

1. Is the patient up to date on Well child visits (1 visit in the past 12 months)? Y/N
 - Any documentation in chart that the patient has had at least 1 WCC visit in the past 12 months.

2. Has the patient completed the required Immunization for 5K-? Y/N
 - Any documentation in the chart that the patient is up to date on required immunizations (up to date for the 5K immunization requirement).

5 year - 6-year-olds (61 months – 72 months or 5 years through 6th birthday)

General and Immunization:

If NO

2a. Vaccine refusal Y/N

- Any documentation in the chart that the patient did not receive immunizations due to “Vaccine Refusal”.

2b. Catch-up schedule Y/N

- Patient not up to date with immunizations but have documentation that a “catch up” schedule is being implemented.

5 year - 6-year-olds (61 months – 72 months or 5 years through 6th birthday)

General and Immunization:

3. Is there documentation of appropriate Z code for BMI? Y/N

Documentation in the chart for the appropriate Z code for BMI.

4. Was a vision screening done? Y/N

Any documentation the chart that a vision screen was done in the last 12 months.

5 year - 6-year-olds (61 months – 72 months or 5 years through 6th birthday)

Screenings:

5. Is there a screening for SDOH in the chart? Y/N

- Any documentation that family has been asked questions about social determinants of health at a health supervision visit in the past 12 months.

If YES

5a. Was the screening positive?

- Any documentation family has been asked questions about social determinants of health at a health supervision visit in the past 12 months and the screen is positive.

5 year - 6-year-olds (61 months – 72 months or 5 years through 6th birthday)

Preventative Oral Health:

6. Was an oral exam done? Y/N

Any documentation in the records that an oral exam was done at least once in the last 12 months.

7. Was an oral health risk factors assessment done? Y/N

Any documentation in the records that an oral health risk assessment was done at least once in the last 12 months.

8. Was a fluoride varnish applied? Y/N

Any documentation in the records that a fluoride varnish has been provided at least once in the last 12 months.

5 year - 6-year-olds (61 months – 72 months or 5 years through 6th birthday)

Preventative Oral Health:

9. Was an anticipatory guidance on oral health given? Y/N

- Any documentation in the record that anticipatory guidance on oral health was given at the last well child visit.

10. Was the patient referred to a dental home? Y/N/Already
Established

- Any documentation in the record that the patient has a dental home or has been referred to a dental home.

11. Did the patient have any restorative dental procedures? Y/N

- Any documentation in the record that restorative dental procedures were done if needed.
