WHEN?

After their **1st** birthday








Why then?
Your child's first tooth starts erupting at the age of 6 months

WHY?

- To build rapport and trust between child and dentist
- Instill positive dental attitude from a young age


WHAT TO EXPECT?


Identification of:

- Oral habits 
- Feeding practices 
- Mouth cleaning 
- Teething 
- Dental injury prevention 

HOW DO I PREPARE?

Ensure your child had a good night's rest the night before the appointment



Stay positive and avoid showing anxiety 

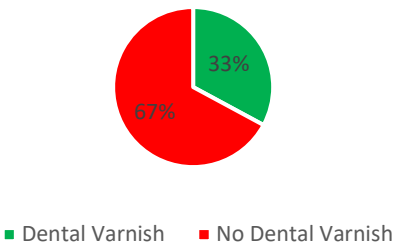
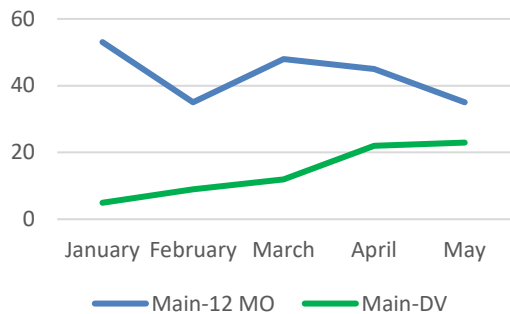

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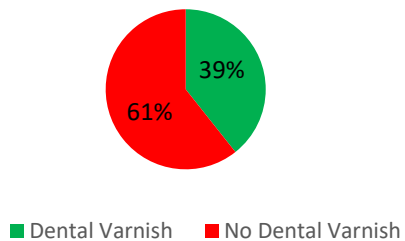

12 Month WCCs (n=216)



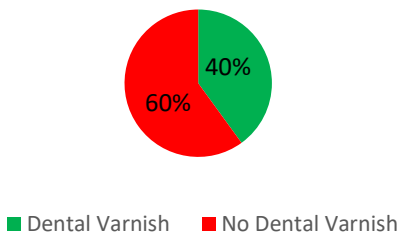
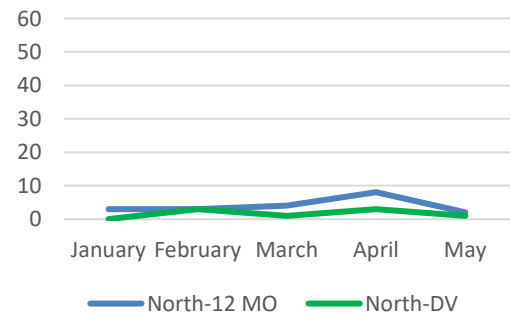
West

12 Month WCCs (n=89)

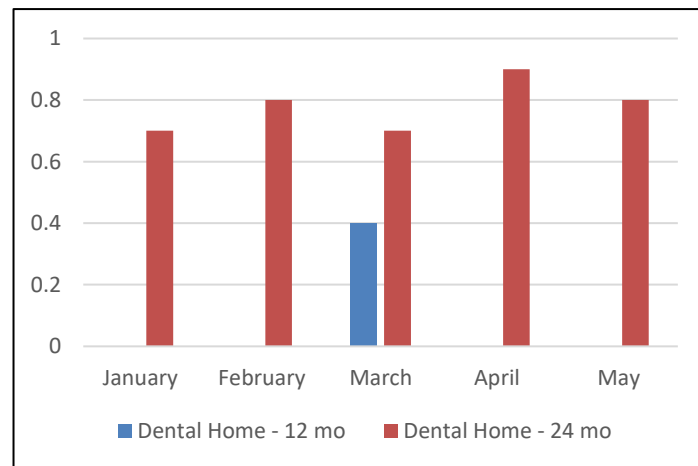


North

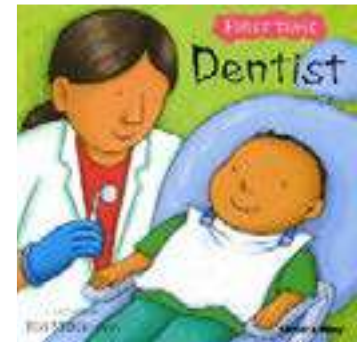
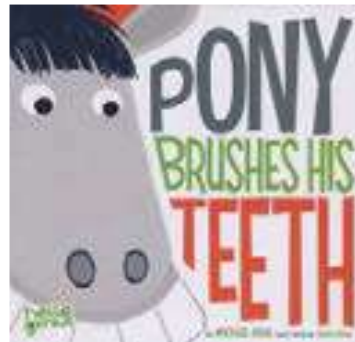
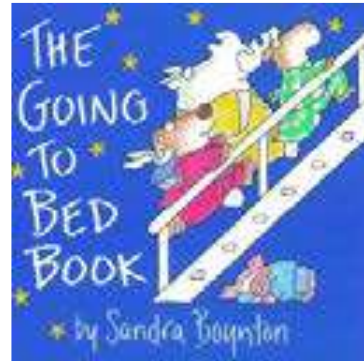
